Altered older production US Apex crosses will not be allowed at the 2005 World Cup.

<sup>1</sup> All wooden crosses are legal. The wooden crosses have been measured, but because wood is a "living" material, they will not be certified. Wooden crosses have set the standard for women's field lacrosse since the game's inception, and their basic design has not undergone significant changes over the years. Future models will be monitored and action will be taken by the IFWLA if warranted.

<sup>2</sup> While STX has a small number of Woodies in their inventory, the STX Woodie is no longer being offered by STX.

<sup>3</sup> While Brine does not currently list the wooden Brine Cup Classic in their catalogue, the crosse legal for the International game.

<sup>4</sup> The identifiable difference between the DeBeer US Apex and Impulse and the new production International Apex and Impulse is that the protrusions at the widest point between the sidewalls at the top of the head have been removed. Identifiable stickers are attached to the throat of the International Apex and the International Impulse.

<sup>5</sup> The Debeer models -- International Apex, International Impulse, Myssy and Response -- are available traditionally strung or with the new pre-sewn Trakker Pocket and Trakker "Pro Pocket".

<sup>6</sup> The IFWLA approved Avanti is a retooled version of Shamrock's US Avanti. This retooled version fits into the 5.1cm horizontal plane.

<sup>7</sup> Due to patent issues in the USA and CA, the Harrow Slingshot will currently only be available for sale overseas in the UK, Europe, Japan and Australia. Those interested in purchasing the Slingshot should contact Harrow Sports via e-mail: [cwittman@harrowsports.com](mailto:cwittman@harrowsports.com). Harrow will eventually have retail outlets overseas.

<sup>8</sup> The Harrow models -- Electra, Slingshot -- are available traditionally strung or with Harrow's pre-sewn "Snap Pocket". The Harrow Solo, International Solo and Vigor were approved for use with the "Snap Pocket". The Solo International has a wider head, higher sidewall, flatter scoop and a straight shaft than the original Solo.

<sup>9</sup> The Warrior models -- Tantrum, Vixen and Wicked -- are available traditionally strung or with Warrior's new "Hot Pocket" pre-sewn pocket.

<sup>10</sup> An IFWLA approved **pre-sewn pocket** may only be used in other approved crosse heads by the same manufacturer. For example, the Warrior "Hot Pocket" may be used only in approved Warrior's three IFWLA Approved heads. DeBeer's "new Trakker Pocket" may only be used in approved DeBeer heads; and the Harrow pre-sewn pocket is legal for use only in other IFWLA approved Harrow heads.)

<sup>11</sup> **PLASTIC/MOULDED HEAD GOALKEEPER CROSSES:** As of January 1, 2005, the Goalkeeper crosse in **RED** are no longer legal for use at IFWLA World Events, Test Matches or at any other events where strict IFWLA Rules are in force. While these crosses were approved for use in the 2003 U-19 World Championships, approved paper work has not been received from the R.I.H. Foundation Laboratory for these crosses. These crosses either have not been submitted to the Lab for evaluation or they did not meet the specifications for Goalkeeper crosses in Rule 3.E.
