It would be advantageous if the candidate can drive, however this is not a prerequisite. You must also have the right to work in the UK.

The ideal candidate will have had previous experience working in schools, academic or community sport settings to coordinate sport at a participation / grassroots level. The successful candidate **must** have of experience working with children under the age of 16, with an emphasis on 8-12 year olds preferable but not mandatory.

The ability to engage and create a sense of fun with children is a higher priority than lacrosse experience.

A basic understanding of fundamentals of catching and throwing is the only lacrosse experience required and our programme can support training for the right candidate.
