COVID-19 CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Minimum Standards of Behaviour & Conduct

Lacrosse can return as long as all participants adhere to EL return to play guidance and Government protocols.

All participants should enter the site wearing masks and maintain social distancing.

Players should use their own equipment, no equipment should be shared.

No one should handle the ball, use your stick to pick up the ball. If anyone does handle the ball they should sanitise it and their hands immediately.

All participants should have their own water bottles (clearly marked)

All participants should sanitise their hands prior to the start of the activity.

Players should refrain from spitting or rinsing their mouth guards out.

All participants should refrain from shouting.

Hand sanitiser should be used at all breaks in activity and prior to consuming food and drink. If the player is wearing gloves there is no need to remove them in the breaks but they should be sanitised.

ENGLAND
